
## **Health Centre Information**

Salt & Snow Removal: This year there is a shortage of salt due to a salt mine strike that took place earlier in the year. As a result, the government had priority on the purchase of salt which added to the shortage. Holland Home was able to purchase approximately half of the normal salt used for the winter season. Because of this, we will only be salting in the licensed areas and when there are extreme ice conditions. Please note that there may be ice and slippery areas on the sidewalks and parking lots, so please be careful. Holland Home will continue the routine snow plowing and shoveling of parking lots and sidewalks when there are snow accumulations of 1.5 inches or more.


