Anyone suffering from a serious illness or disease who has been given six months or less to live can enter hospice care. A hospice care team consists of:

- Physicians
- RN Case Manager
- Team Manager
- Nurses
- Social Worker
- Home Health Aides
- Chaplains
- Volunteers

Together, they work to enhance the quality of life for each patient. The goal is not to stop or slow the illness but to provide comfort and support to those who are dying and their loved ones.

In-Home Hospice Care

Inpatient at Trillium Woods

Our Trillium Woods staff specializes in hospice care, serving with expertise and compassion. Whatever the need, whether it’s a short-term stay that focuses on stabilizing symptoms so patients can return home more comfortably, a more long-term stay, or respite stays to relieve caregivers, Trillium Woods offers a peaceful, family-centered atmosphere with 24/7 care. Plus, each of our 20 private rooms features convenient pullout sofas, private bathrooms, and peaceful balconies or patios. Trillium Woods also offers a nondenominational chapel for worship, prayer, or meditation.
