Submit financial information to determine if resources meet admission criteria.

Fill out an application—there may be a waiting list.

A nurse manager from our team will meet with the prospective resident to determine their level of care.

A prospective resident must undergo a physical examination no more than 90 days prior to admission.

6

Our Continuing Care Agreement (CCA) is signed, and we work to coordinate a move-in date.
